

## Mandatory COVID-19 Vaccination Event Policy



Cabrillo National Monument Foundation (CNMF) has a duty to maintain a workplace that is free of known hazards and to help enhance the visitor experience at Cabrillo National Monument. As such, CNMF is adopting a vaccination policy to safeguard the health of its leadership, employees, visitors, and the community from COVID-19.

Under this Policy, **all attendees of CNMF sanctioned *in-person* meetings or events are required to provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination, with exception of a doctor approved health condition or religious beliefs.** Attendees who are not able to comply with this policy will not be permitted to attend the event or may be required to undertake additional safety protocols.

All attendees must:

- Provide valid proof of vaccination in the form of:
  - white issued vaccination card; or
  - state issued QR code from personal digital COVID-19 vaccine record
- Provide proof either before the event or prior to entry
- Wear a mask
- Practice social distancing of 6 feet apart
- Follow the rules and regulations of the National Park Service (if event is at the Park)
