Making a Bequest

A bequest to CNMF can be made for a specific amount or for all or a portion of what is left after you have made bequests to your family. To make a gift to CNMF from your estate, you must sign a new will or living trust instrument, add a codicil to your present will, or make an amendment to your present trust instrument.

To assist you in preparing your bequest, we have provided sample bequest language below.

Planning Your Bequest

An unrestricted bequest allows CNMF to determine how to use the funds based on its and Cabrillo National Monument's most pressing needs. Unrestricted bequests are extremely valuable because CNMF can use them flexibly to meet its future needs.
