Your voice for a trail to safely connect from the upper monument near the Old Point Loma Lighthouse to the lower section at the tidepools was heard and without your support this trail would not have happened for a long time.

The new trail, now called the *Ocean Side Trail*, is in its final phase of construction. Joshua Tree Trail Crew is leading the construction efforts with help from the Urban Corps and California Conservation Corps. These crews also serve as first responders and as you can imagine, have occasionally been pulled away from construction due to wildfires and Hurricane Hilary. We are hopeful the crews will return to Cabrillo in January 2024.
